Article VI

Replace 2.4 with the following:

The regular work year for other regular unit employees shall be no more than one hundred eighty-five (185) days; except that in the case of new unit employees, the regular work year shall be one hundred eighty-six (186) days. Of these work days, one hundred eighty (180) shall be instructional days.

For the school years 2016-17 and 2017-2018, professional development days shall be added to the work year. These additional days shall be embedded within the 180 student instructional days. The Teaching and Learning Advisory Council (TLAC) will determine the content of these professional development days.

For the school year 2016-17, the regular work year for other regular unit employees shall be one hundred eighty-seven (187) days; except that in the case of new unit employees, the regular work year shall be one hundred eighty-eight (188) days. Of these work days, one hundred eighty (180) shall be instructional days. For the school year 2017-18, the regular work year for other regular unit employees shall be no more than one hundred eighty-eighty (188) days; except that in the case of new unit employees, the regular work year shall be one hundred eighty-nine (189) days. Of these work days, one hundred eighty (180) shall be instructional days.
